Regional delegate report for meeting 4/12/2025

I apologize for not being with you face to face in February I was invited to share at the out of darkness convention in Decatur Alabama. Thank you to vice chair for bring my information to the group.

RD attended the MZF meeting live in metro Detroit region February 21-23.

- Included orientation to the Interim WSC, introduction of new delegates, networking, and presentations from zonal committees: Sponsorship Behind the Walls, Mentorship, Collaboration of US Zones!
- MZF recognizes availability to be providing more services to our Regions, we held brainstorming sessions on needed services!
- One big take away is most regions are meeting in hybrid formats, and have also adopted some type of payment platform for donations. Tri-state relays they have increased donations by 70% in the past year.
- Next in-person meeting of the MZF will be in the Buckeye Region in August of 2025, MZF has pre-approved budget for regions of \$800 to make arrangements for hotel and meeting space.
- MZF donated \$2000 to World Services.

RD attended interim WSC virtually on feb 28-march 1.

Major takeaways:

- We had considerable tech issues (it took 90 minutes to take attendance)!
- Results of motions is on NA.org – I have printed a copy for the minutes.
- Major point of information: After the passing of Motion 1, no formal voting occurred unless the initial straw poll did not show consensus for against the following motions
- Motion 2: Yes (passed)!
- Motion 3: Yes (passed after initial straw poll)
- Motion 4: Yes (passed after initial straw poll)
- Motion 5: Yes (passed after initial straw poll)
- Motion 6: Yes (passed after initial straw poll)

Interim WSC 2025 Draft Summary of Decisions

7 March 2025

CONFERENCE FIRSTS

Interim WSC 2025 was the first . . .

- intentional virtual Interim WSC meeting.
- WSC meeting to review an interim strategic plan draft. Conference participants reviewed the key result areas, issues, and objectives. The solutions have not been drafted yet.
- WSC meeting with a majority of seated participants from outside the US (although 5 non-US participants were not present.)

STATISTICS ON PARTICIPANTS ATTENDING INTERIM WSC 2025

- There were 144 voting members participating at this WSC—129 delegates and 15 World Board members. In addition, there were 89 alternate delegates, plus 4 HRP members, 2 cofacilitators, and 8 translators.
- We also enlisted 15 volunteers, most former world level trusted servants, to help facilitate and take notes in the breakout rooms on day two of the conference.
- Of 128 seated regions, there were 123 RDs participating. Of 6 seated zones, 6 ZDs were participating.
- This was the first WSC that Brazil Central Region, Iran Region #1, Nordeste Brazil Region, Rio Grande do Sul Region, and Thailand Region participated as seated members.
- Baja Son, El Salvador, Nicaragua, Quebec, and Venezuela were not in attendance.
- Of the 129 delegates from seated regions and zones participating, 66 were from the US, 4 from Canada, and 59 from outside the US and Canada.
- We had 89 alternate delegates from seated regions or zones participating, 45 from the US, 3 from Canada, and 41 from outside of the US or Canada.
- This year's conference participants were from 44 countries.

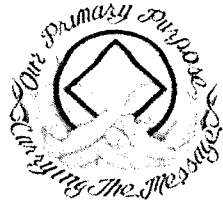

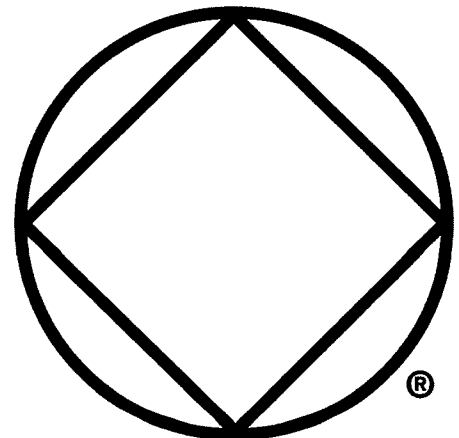
