Since our last Regional meeting :

- RD attended virtual meeting of MZF on November 1st, 2025
- CAR released 10/30/25, discussions at MZF focused on CAR Motions and IDT's
- Next meeting of the MZF is in person Minnesota February 13-15
- RD attended a WSC Conference participant webinar Oct 10th, 2025

Webinar discussion focused on CAR and questions posed by delegates. Conference participants will be voting on straw polls after April 18th, as a region we should have all final votes by the April 11th, 2026 Region meeting.

- In discussion: how do regions record their votes? Many were presented, from online surveys to individual groups votes, typically we have had areas vote and RCM's bring to region, do we still want to follow that path. Personally I like the thought of an online survey, however that may not be realistic with no webmaster. Feed back on this would be welcome.
- Buckeye is encouraged to provide a report of our well being for WSC, I have never seen or provided one of these, I am not sure what we want included, so could use some feedback.

- MOTIONS: proposals that require a vote by conference participants; 3 are from the World Board, 2 are from Regions.

- **Motion 1: Maker: World Board Motion:** Approve the revised IP#21, Staying Clean in Isolation, contained in addendum A, as Fellowship-approved recovery literature to replace the current IP#21, The Loner—Staying Clean in Isolation Intent: To update this IP originally approved in 1986 with current Fellowship experience Financial Impact: none at this time Policy Affected: none

- **Motion 2: Maker: World Board Motion:** To adopt the collaboratively created 2026-2029 NA World Services Strategic Plan continued in Addendum B Intent: To approve the results of the collaborative planning that began at WSC 2023 and continued with zonal and conference participant involvement throughout this cycle Financial Impact: No direct financial impact. Any future expenses will be called out in project plans or budgets Policy Affected: none

- **Motion 3: Maker: World Board Motion:** To hold the World Convention of Narcotics Anonymous (WCNA) every 5 years, beginning in 2028. The location to be determined by the World Board based on fiscal and geographic considerations that lend themselves to, at minimum, a revenue-neutral event (The specific changes to the WCNA Guidelines in GWSNA are shown in Addendum C) Intent: To have

guidelines for the World Convention (WCNA) that reflect the changing nature of large events worldwide and support the prudent use of Fellowship resources Financial Impact: No direct financial impact.

• **Motion 4: Maker: Arizona Region Co-Makers: Florida, Ohio, Northern California, Southern California, Sweden, UK, Utah Motion:** To direct the World Board to create a project plan for consideration at WSC 2029 to research and explore the opportunities and instances of providing book length pieces of literature to the incarcerated, on tablets, in addition to the IPs and audio version of the Fifth Edition Basic Text that already exist on inmate tablets. Intent: To give the Conference and Fellowship the ability to meaningfully discuss the opportunities and obstacles of making book length piece of literature available to the incarcerated on tablets Financial Impact: There is minimal cost in creating a project plan. The cost to NAVS would be in the project itself if the WSC were to adopt and prioritize the plan Policy Affected: none

• **Motion 5: Maker: South Florida Region Co-Makers: Iran, UK, Nepal Motion:** To direct the World Board, to implement artificial intelligence (AI) interpretation solutions for WSC meetings (both in-person and virtual) to replace the current human live language interpretation Intent: To eliminate language barriers, ensuring that all voices are heard globally, enhancing our communication and time efficiency during business meetings. This initiative also aims to reduce the risk of human interpretation error and potential absences during our sessions. Financial Impact: The financial impact of implementing this technology is expected to be significant but has not yet been determined pending further analysis. Policy Affected: None

• **ISSUE DISCUSSION TOPICS:** important subjects are presented for discussion at the WSC to gather feedback from the fellowship

• **Gender-Neutral and Inclusive Language** (important note: at this time, there is only reference to neutralizing the pronouns of Higher Power/God where it is mentioned, we are not yet looking at overhauling all of our literature)
• Question Posed: Given that we all want to provide a safe, welcoming, inclusive Fellowship where everyone can recover (regardless of...), are we willing to explore these types of changes in literature in order to carry the message more effectively? If not, why not?

• **DRT/MAT in NA:** Helping Members Take Root

• Questions Posed: Does your group or area ask members whether they're on MAT when they step up to celebrate or serve? What do you do next? Given our differences, how can we foster unity and respect each member's recovery process? How do we get past our personal reservations and help newer members root in our local communities if their process differs from our own?
• Future IDs can be voted on by completing the online CAR survey

• SURVEYS: for members to prioritize future literature and service material projects. Completing these surveys will help us to determine what the fellowship wants delegates to discuss during discussion time at the WSC—the surveys tell us which of the issue discussion topics are the most important to you, so please fill them out! Good morning, Family

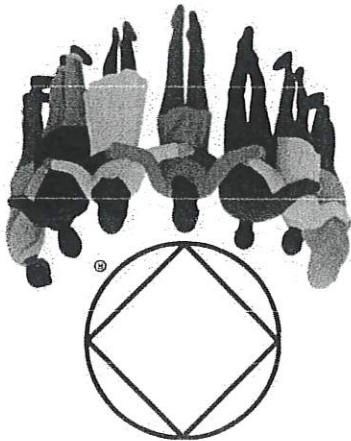
